I., April 20—Word was received in this village this morning that the appellate division of the Supreme Court has sustained an interlocutory judgment entered on a demurrer to the complaint in the somewhat famous Montauk Indians suit against the Long Island Railroad Company, thus ending favorably to the railroad one of Suffolk County's best known lawsuits, wherein the Shinnecock Indians endeavored to gain possession of a very large and valuable tract of land at Montauk, now occupied by the railroad company.
