

## MONTAUK INDIAN SACHEM ISSUES CALL FOR POWWOW

Sag Harbor, L. I., Aug. 26—A call issued by James E. Waters, who assumes the sachemship of the Montauk Indians, appoints Aug. 31 as time for

holding the annual powwow of the tribe, and the place, Sag Harbor. Two sessions will be convened, one at 2 p.m., the other at 8 p.m.

By court decision of Justice Bannard, some years ago, the remnant of the Montauk Indians was declared to

be no longer existing as a tribe, but notwithstanding this some 30 descendants of King Wyandanch still meet yearly and continue tribal relations and customs. The principal object of the Indians is to recover lands at Montauk, which they claim have been unlawfully taken from them.
