

INDIANS' SUIT GOES OVER.

Claim of Wyandank Pharaoh to Entire Montauk Peninsula Is to Be Heard Later.

Riverhead, L. I., April 7—An important case marked off the calendar of the Supreme Court, in session here, is that of Wyandank Pharaoh, as chief of the Montauk Indians, against Jane Ann Benson et al., in which the Indians are suing to regain possession of the whole of the valuable Montauk Peninsula, originally owned, they claim by their ancestors. The Bensons, the Long Island Railroad and others are to put up a stiff fight to defeat the case. It will be tried in Patchogue before Justice Jaycox some time in April, it is expected.
